

**BY-LAW #1-2005
OF THE
TOWN OF VERMILION
(hereinafter referred to as the “Municipality”)
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF VERMILION
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE OPERATION
OF SNOW VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF VERMILION

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 M-26 as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, empowers the Council of the Town of Vermilion to pass Bylaws not inconsistent with the Municipal Government Act respecting activities and things in, on, or near a public place or, place that is open to the public.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 M-26 as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, empowers the Council of the Town of Vermilion to pass Bylaws respecting the safety, health, and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Traffic Safety Act, R.S.A. 2000 cT-6 as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, empowers the Council of the Town of Vermilion to pass Bylaws not inconsistent with the Traffic Safety Act respecting highways under its direction, control, and management for the regulation and control of snow vehicles on any portion, or any such highway or class of highway, and may restrict the hours during which that operation may take place.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Vermilion deems it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Town to regulate and control snow vehicles in relation to highways and public places within the Town of Vermilion.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council for the Town of Vermilion in the Province of Alberta duly assembled and pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act and the Traffic Safety Act hereby enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw #10-2000 is hereby amended by adding the following:
 - 10.1 A snow vehicle may leave a designated route referred to in Section 8 identified on Schedule 1 or, the ditch of a highway referred to in Section 9 or, a parking lane of a highway referred to in Section 10 if the owner or operator of the snow vehicle:
 - a) is accessing or egressing a business for the purpose of obtaining fuel directly from the pumps for the snow vehicle and;
 - b) travels at a rate of speed, not in excess of 30 km per hour and;
 - c) travels in single file in the same direction as vehicles travelling on the highway and approach way and;
 - d) yields the right of way to all other persons and vehicles.

2. Should any provision of this Bylaw be determined to be invalid then such provisions shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

3. This Bylaw shall come into force upon receiving third and final reading and having been signed by the Mayor and Municipal Manager.
